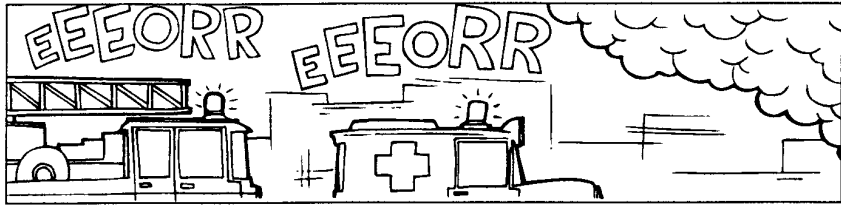


Accidents
