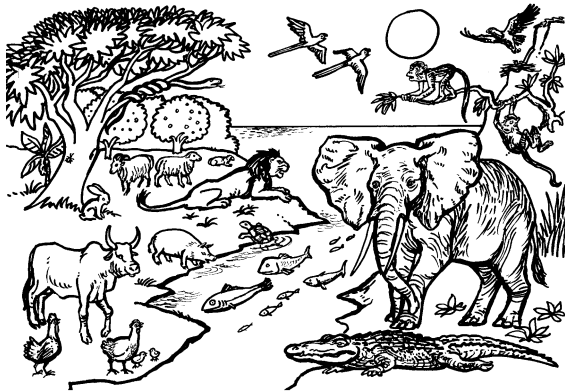


Bible Stories Set 1: story 1

Mark 2: 1-12

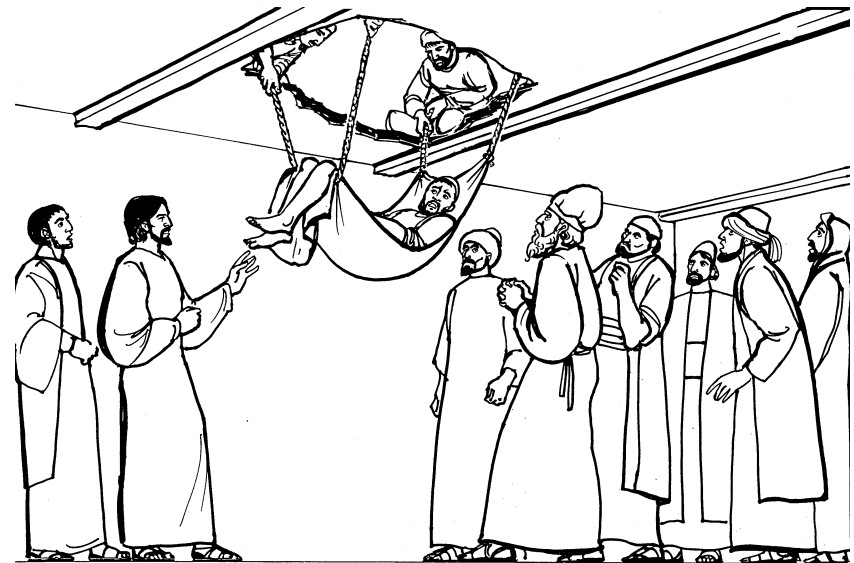
There was a sick man. He could not walk. He had to lie on a little bed.

Zacchaeus was very small. Zacchaeus was very rich. He loved money.

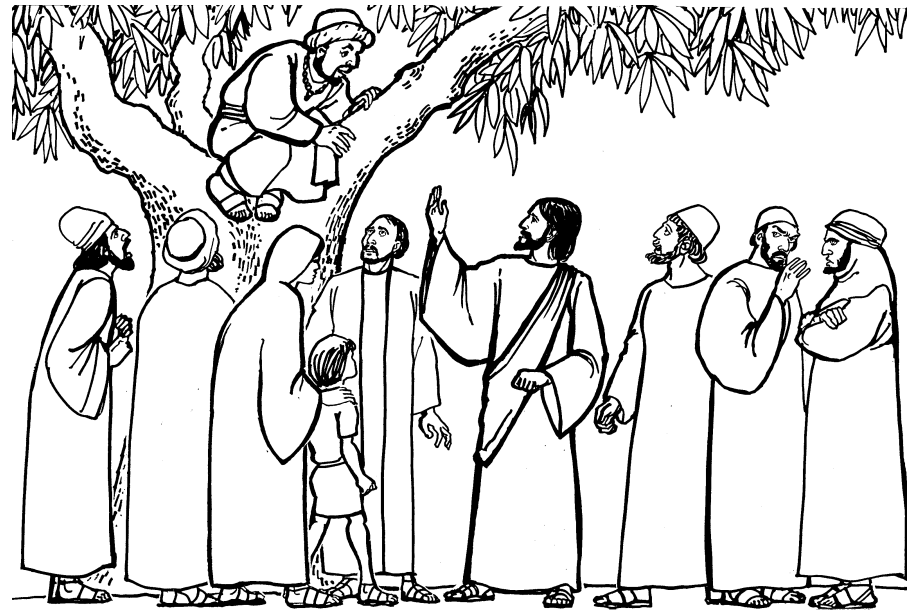
Zacchaeus took money that was not his.
