Genesis 1, Philippians 4:19

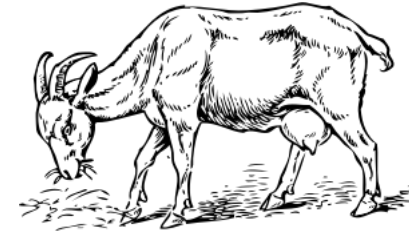
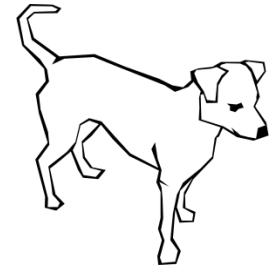
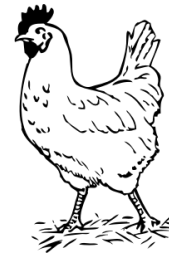
Do you know how much God loves us? He loves us more than anyone. He wants to give us good things.
