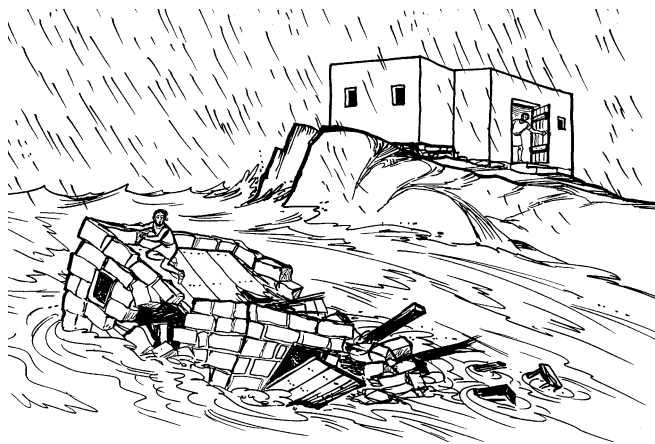
The wise man and the foolish man

God said to Noah, "Make a big, big boat. I am going to send lots of rain."

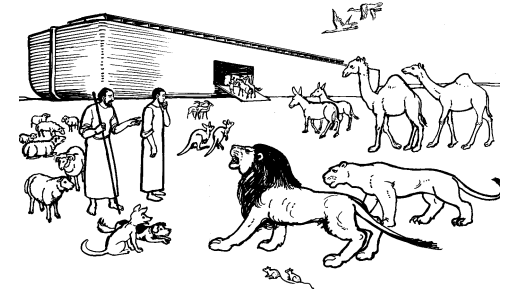
"How big?" asked Noah.

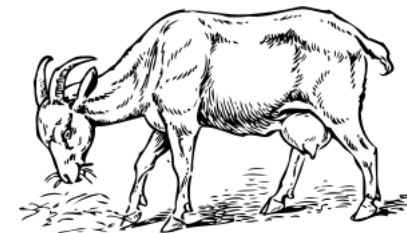
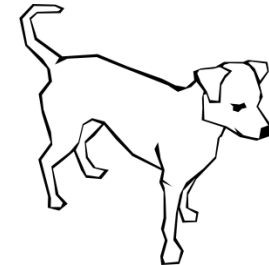
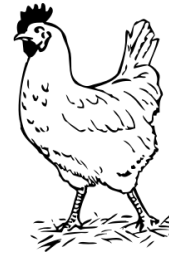
He made air and water so that we could live. Only the earth has air to breathe and water to drink.
