## Answers

Answers will vary. Here are samples of possible answers.

- 1. She will take you to the mall. (although)

  She will take you to the mall although it is late.
- 2. You must shower. *(before)*You must shower **before** you get dressed.
- 3. He will try it your way. *(even though)*He will try it your way **even though** he is not sure it will work.
- 4. They need to practice every day. *(if)*They need to practice every day **if** they want to enter the competition.
- 5. They will eat their dinner. *(once)*They will eat their dinner **once** everyone is sitting down.
- 6. He emptied the garbage. *(after)*He emptied the garbage **after** his dad asked him to.
