### Answers

Answers will vary. Here are samples of possible answers.

1. She will take you to the mall. (*although*)  
She will take you to the mall **although** it is late.
2. You must shower. (*before*)  
You must shower **before** you get dressed.
3. He will try it your way. (*even though*)  
He will try it your way **even though** he is not sure it will work.
4. They need to practice every day. (*if*)  
They need to practice every day **if** they want to enter the competition.
5. They will eat their dinner. (*once*)  
They will eat their dinner **once** everyone is sitting down.
6. He emptied the garbage. (*after*)  
He emptied the garbage **after** his dad asked him to.
