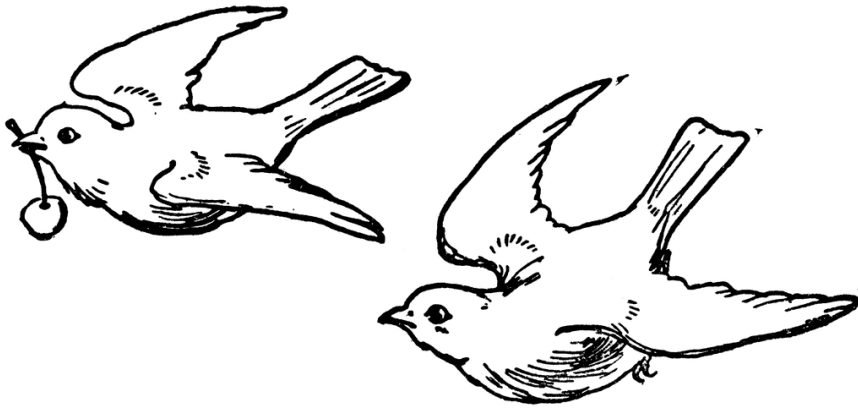
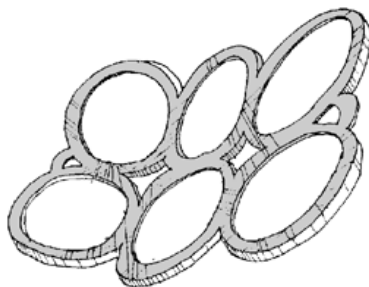


## Week 6: Taking care of God's provision

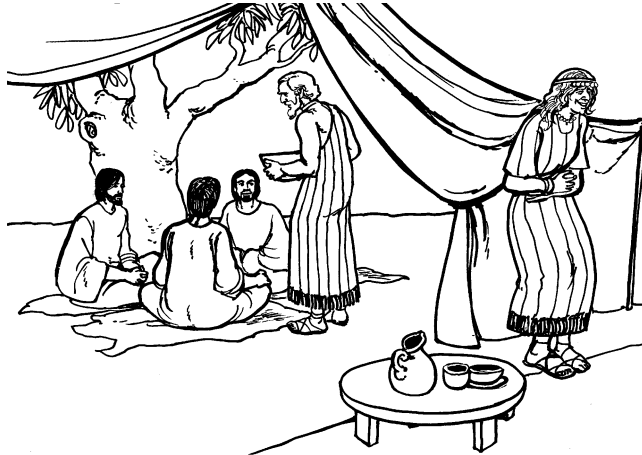

He did not want to give up his friends / money.

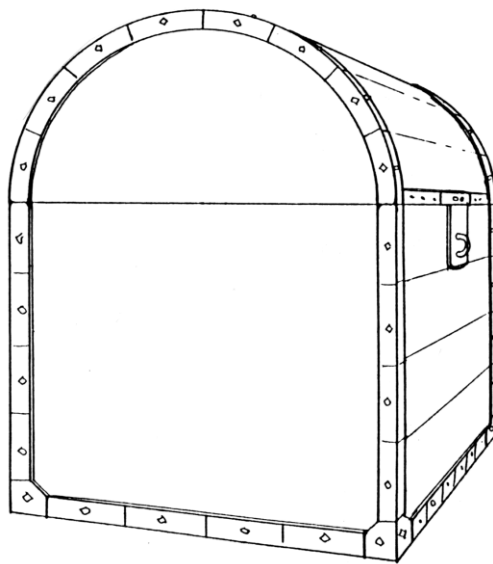
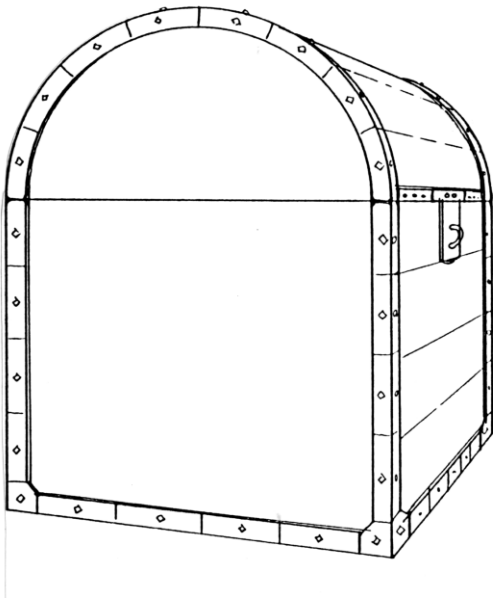
So the man chose to follow Jesus / walk away.
