

Foundation Year Writing Samples

Here are two examples where the student makes up a sentence about their own drawing, and an adult writes the sentence for them. The advantage is, that the writing will be legible and can be used as a reading exercise as well.



Later in the year the student can 'have a go' at writing their own sentence. Do not discourage them by insisting that everything has to be perfect. However, on a separate piece of paper you could write the sentence: "I see a big crab" and use it as a reading exercise, e.g. as a "cut-up sentence" where they have to put the sentence back together with the words in the right order.
