- Know the true meaning of our Easter celebrations
- Understand that God's gift is for the whole world
- Understanding more about where I live community, climate, food, environment, diverse cultures, traditions, history, geography

Skills

- locate relevant information from sources provided
- use a range of communication forms (oral, graphic, written) and digital technologies

Values

- appreciate all that God has provided for my country
- appreciate the rich resources that God has provided
- appreciate the diverse cultural groups within my country
- understand that God loves all people the same, no matter what colour skin they
 have, what language they speak, what clothes they wear, or what country they
 come from.

Activities

The world

- What is the world? What does it look like from out in space? What is *in* the world?
- Find out the names of some countries. You have to go on a boat or aeroplane to get there. The world is also called "the earth".

- Show a globe so that they can see that the earth is a like a ball.
- In some countries it is very different to our country. Some places are very hot and some are very cold. Some have seasons: summer when it is hot and winter when it is cold.
- Identify Australia on a world map.
- Make a large circle from paper, representing the world. You can draw some countries on it: e.g. Fiji, Australia, New Zealand, Papua New Guinea. Paint inside it – blue for sea and green for land. Place Scripture verse underneath: John 3:16



- Go on an excursion to places in your local community e.g. park, shops, library
- Make a book about your local community
- Draw a map of where you live draw your road of street, draw your house, your neighbours house and other key landmarks
