People are God's special creation; We are made in God's image, with the ability to think, feel and choose. Memory Verse: How great is the love of God our Father, that we are called children of God. 1 John.3:1a Monday: People are special to God – more special than animals. God loves everyone. (Ask children to turn to a partner and think of something special about that person.) God made everyone special and loves everyone very much. We are the same in some ways. We have eyes and feet, but different in other ways. (Ask children to think of ways in which people are different.) Everyone is special to God. He told us that He even knows how many hairs on our heads! (Mt.10:29-31) Tuesday: Memory verse – John 3:1a. Who are God's children? We are. How much does God the Father love us? Does He love some people more than others?	 Topic: The human body introduce and name body parts pointing out their specific purposes or abilities. Try out different movements, e.g. Ask, 'What can our hands do?' wave, grasp, point, stroke, rub, scratch, tickle, clap, etc. What are our 5 senses? Do some experimenting with them all. 

Matthew 10:31 Monday: Who is Jesus? Jesus is God's Son. Like God the Father, Jesus is God. He has always been there. About 2,000 years ago, God sent His Son from heaven to earth as a baby. Jesus was born in Bethlehem, Israel. Like other children, Jesus learned to talk and read and help His parents. But Jesus was different too: He never did anything wrong. He never had bad thoughts or and never made wrong choices. He was not only person but also perfect, holy God. Tuesday: the importance of names. Why do we have names? When do we use names? How many names do we have? (First and second name) Do you know anyone who has exactly the same name as you? Do you know the meaning of your name? Within the week's theme of God's goodness, emphasize God's goodness in meeting the desperate need, God's goodness knowing and caring about the problem and sadness of this poor family, and God's goodness in providing abundance God's goodness in hearing our prayers for help.

Health aspects of oil: This is a good opportunity for *teachers* to learn about the health aspects of oil. Oil and fat are essential to help us absorb nutrients, to protect our cells and for energy. There are good fats and bad fats. The Bible tells us about good fats: olive oil is a most stable oil and good for our health. "Stable" means that it does not change very much with heat, whereas cheap oils like canola oils change easily to for a potentially cancer producing oil that can damage our cells. Margarine is also in this category, (a bad fat). People of Bible times would have used butter, which is a natural product, very stable, and gives Vitamins A,D,E and K. Coconut oil is a good fat because it helps us burn other fats.





Ask a question, e.g. what did you have for breakfast today? Or 'what's your favourite thing to play with?' Pass around an object for them to hold in their hand while they talk. They pass on when they are finished. Only the person holding this object is allowed to speak, and they need to wait until it comes around to their turn.

The Good Shepherd

Jesus sometimes told stories about sheep and shepherds. In the land where Jesus lived a shepherd was a person who looked after the sheep. He always carried a crook with him as well as a sling shot, in case wild animals tried to run off with one of the sheep. A shepherd had to be very brave. If a wolf or a lion or a bear came along, he would protect the sheep. He would use the sling-shot to hurl a stone at the animal and his crook to fight it off.

A shepherd also helped a sheep out of trouble. Sometimes a sheep wandered into thick prickle bushes and couldn't get out. Then the shepherd would gently lift the sheep out of the bushes and put it back with the others. Sometimes sheep were troublesome. They wouldn't go where they were meant to. Then the shepherd used his crook to make them go the right way.

A shepherd loved his sheep very much. He even had a name for every sheep. What do you think some of their names might be? The sheep knew the shepherd too. They knew the sound of his voice and could pick it out amongst other voices. Can you recognise the voice of your Mum or Dad.....even when you can't see them? You know their voices very, very well, and that's how it was with the shepherd and his sheep.

Sometimes bad men came along to the sheep-fold and tried to steal the sheep. The bad men didn't go through the gate, but crept under the fence and hid behind a bush. Then they called to one of the sheep to come to them. But the sheep wouldn't come. It didn't know the stranger's voice. Instead, the sheep ran to the sheepherd knowing that the sheepherd would protect it.

Jesus told this story about the shepherd and the sheep because He wants us to love Him just as the sheep love their shepherd. Jesus is like our shepherd because He loves us. He protects us from danger and always cares for us. Jesus wants us to follow Him, just like the sheep follow the shepherd. They wouldn't follow anyone else because they only know the voice of the shepherd.

Samuel ran to Eli. "Here I am," he said. Then Eli knew that it was God calling.


He said, "Go and lie down. If you hear the voice again, say, "Speak Lord, I am listening,"



Saul escapes in a basket

Remember the story of Saul, who used to kill Christians? (Saul's name was later changed to Paul.) One day Jesus came to him when he was on the road. Jesus came as a bright light, and He spoke to Saul and said that he had to stop killing Christians. Saul knew it was Jesus, and became a follower. Now Saul believed that Jesus was sent by Father God and he wanted to tell others about Jesus too. His old 'friends' (who didn't love Jesus) still wanted to stop the Christians and now they were angry with Saul too and wanted to stop him! The city of Damascus, like most cities in those days was built with the houses and other buildings inside a big tall wall which went all around for protection. There were gates and windows in the wall, but anyone going in or out had to go through the gates in the wall. So, Saul would have been seen if he just ran or walked out of Damascus in the daytime. God gave some of his friends a very clever idea. They found a big basket and tied a strong rope to it. At night, when no one was looking, Saul got in the basket, and the friends lowered it down over the wall, so no knew he had escaped. God protected him, and Saul continued to tell many people about Jesus.

True story of Brother Andrew

As a boy, Brother Andrew, grew up in a country called Holland. When Andrew grew older, he wanted to help Christians in some of the countries near-by, that were not allowed to have Bibles. He would drive his van to those countries, carrying Bibles in secret places in the van.

One time, on the journey, he started to feel hungry so decided to stop for some lunch. He drove down to the river bank. Along came a boat. The boat stopped where Brother Andrew was eating lunch. There were two soldiers in the boat. "Lord," Andrew prayed, "help me not to be afraid."

The first soldier held the machine-gun at Andrew, while the other one ran to the van. Andrew kept eating his lunch. He heard the car door open. The soldiers were looking to see if he was carrying anything they didn't like – Bibles!

Andrew reached into his picnic box and drew out two extra plates. He asked one of the soldiers to down and share some food. The soldier shook his head. Andrew could hear the other soldier poking around. Any moment now he was going to ask about those boxes that the Bibles were in. Andrew prayed, and then an amazing thing happened. While he prayed there was no sound from the soldier inspecting his car. Just as soon as he had finished praying, the door slammed. Andrew heard the sound of footsteps coming towards him. For a moment both soldiers stood over him. Then quickly they ran to their boat, got in and sped away. That was the last he saw of them.

Jesus is tempted by Satan

When Jesus grew up to be a man, He obeyed God, just as He did when He was a boy. One day He went for a long walk in the desert. *What is a desert like?* (*discuss*) He stayed there many days. He did not take food with Him and had no one to talk to. He just wanted to be alone with God.

The bad angel, Satan, was there in the desert too. You cannot see this bad angel, but you can see the things that he does. He makes people do evil things. Satan thought that this would be a good time to make Jesus do something wrong. Satan talked to Jesus.

"Why don't you listen to me?" he said. "If you are hungry, why don't you turn these stones into bread?" Jesus said, "No. God says that the word of God is more important than food." (Jesus knew that He did not come to use His special power for Himself, but for others.) Then Satan came again: "You could do some fantastic tricks like jumping from this high point. Everyone would think how great you are if you jumped and didn't hurt yourself. The angels would hold you and stop you from being hurt."

Jesus knew that this was not what God wanted Him to do. Jesus didn't need to jump off a high place to make people think he was important. Jesus must do only the things that *God* told Him to do. God was His Heavenly Father and He must obey Him only.

"Get away from me Satan," said Jesus. "God's word says that we don't have to do anything to prove that God is powerful. He just IS." Jesus said "*no*" to Satan. Satan came again and said, "When you are standing up high you can see the cities of the world. Satan said, "I will give you all these cities if you worship me." Jesus said 'no' again to Satan. He said:" The word of God says, 'Worship the Lord your God, and serve him only.'" After a while Satan left Jesus. Sometimes Satan speaks to us as well. He doesn't speak in a loud voice. He only speaks through our thoughts. Perhaps he might make us think about being unkind to someone, or telling a lie. When we have those bad thoughts, we must say 'no' to Satan, just as Jesus did. We can say a verse that we know from the Bible.

Jesus calls his disciples

Jesus was walking along the water's edge by the sea of Galilee. He saw at the water's edge two boats, left there by the fishermen, who were washing their nets. He got into one of the boats, the one belonging to Simon. Jesus asked Simon to take the boat a little from the shore. Then he sat down and taught the people from the boat.

When he had finished speaking, he said to Simon, "Take the boat out into deep water, and let down the nets for a catch."

Simon answered, "Master, we've worked hard all night and haven't caught anything. But because you say so, I will let down the nets."

When they let down the nets, they caught such a large number of fish that their nets began to break. They called James and John who were in another boat, to come and help them, and they came and filled both boats so full that they began to sink.

When Simon saw this, he fell at Jesus' knees and knew that Jesus was from God.

Then Jesus said to Simon, "Don't be afraid; from now on you will fish for people." So, they pulled their boats up on shore, left everything and followed him.

Nicodemus

Nicodemus had fancy clothes. He was rich. Nicodemus was a Pharisee. Pharisees were people from the church at the time when Jesus walked on earth. They knew some of the Bible - about when God made the world, and about Moses, but they didn't know that Jesus was God's Son. In fact, they didn't like Jesus. They didn't really love God. They just followed a lot of rules. But there was one Pharisee who was different. His name was Nicodemus. He wanted to find out about Jesus. He came to Jesus very quietly at night. Why at night? Probably because he didn't want the other Pharisees to know that he wanted to find out more about Jesus. He might have knocked at the door of Jesus' house, and Jesus would have let him in. Then they sat down and had a talk.

"How can I get to know God more?" asked Nicodemus. Jesus told him that he had to 'born again'.

"How can I do this?" asked Nicodemus. "I can't get back into my mummy's tummy and be born all over again!"

"No," said Jesus. "But you can have a new start in life, just like a little baby coming into the world has a new start. You have to decide to love God with all your heart, mind, soul and strength, and to love and follow Him forever."

We don't know whether Nicodemus changed because the Bible doesn't tell us, but we hope that he did. And everyone in the world can have a chance to make a new start in life by asking Jesus to come and be their special friend.


The Ascension of Jesus

Jesus blessed his disciples. Then as they look at him Jesus became surrounded by bright light. A cloud came down and He was taken into the sky, and he disappeared.


