Reptiles

Snakes are reptiles. Alligators and crocodiles are reptiles.

Lizards are reptiles. Geckoes are small lizards.

Turtles are reptiles. Tortoises are reptiles.

Some reptiles crawl on short legs.

Snakes wriggle along and have no legs.

Most reptiles lay eggs.

Reptiles have scales on their skin.

Turtles and tortoises have heavy shells on their backs. The have some scales too.

Shells and scales <u>protect</u> reptiles from other animals and from the hot sun.

Some snakes have poisonous bites. They will attack animals that want to eat them. This is how they <u>protect</u> themselves.

When the day is warm, the reptile's blood is warm.

When the day is cold, the reptiles blood is cold. They like to rest in the sun to get warm.

Because their blood can get cold reptiles are called cold blooded.

Reptiles breathe with lungs.

All reptiles have backbones.
