Most shellfish with one shell live on rocks. These shellfish have a large foot to help it cling to the rocks.

The shellfish also uses its foot to move with.

Most shellfish with two shells live in the sand or the mud.

These shellfish use their large foot to dig in the sand.

A clam hides from other animals by doing this.

Some shellfish eat tiny plants and animals that float about in the water.

Most shellfish live in the sea.

Some shellfish live in rivers or lakes.

Shellfish belong to the snail family. Snails live on land.

Many shellfish are good to eat. Some people eat snails too.

Fish like to eat shellfish too.

The shell of a shellfish <u>protects</u> it from small fish.

A shellfish does not have a backbone. It has a shell instead.
