

Introduction to GCC

God-centred curriculum means

- every subject can involve God, (Father, Son and Holy Spirit)
- there is opportunity for teachers to share God's perspective on all learning.
- God is not confined to a specialized compartment called "Bible lessons".



GCC is relevant to life

 The curriculum as a whole, aims to help students to grow to be strong, outstanding leaders of tomorrow.





Character development

- There is a focus on character development, not coming from pride of human effort, but from a desire to please God.
- This goes beyond 'values' that people have decided are important. It teaches God's values.



Inspiring and Engaging

- The thematic nature of the curriculum helps students follow a path of **interest** over some weeks.
- This is different to random, scattered topics.




World geography

- The curriculum includes history, geography and environment...
- as well as providing an understanding of the continents and nations of the world.



Creativity

- The curriculum includes thinking skills, which help the students to think laterally, and to problem solve in real life situations.
- There is also plenty of opportunity for students to express their creativity though creative arts.



Practical Science

- The curriculum has a large bank of practical science experiments for all levels and all ages.
- The small class sizes make it possible to undertake more 'hands-on' activities, and not just book work.




The Teachers

- The teachers who teach the GCC have hearts that are totally committed to serving the Lord.
- They will be called to the job, and do not undertake the job because the conditions look better than in government schools.
- They look upon their job with the attitude of a missionary, understanding that they are part of an important pioneer movement in Christian education, and will be willing to make sacrifices for the cause.

Unity

- The teachers will work together as a unified team, helping each other, and going the extra mile to solve problems that arise when necessary.
- There is unity as the whole school studies the same aspect of God's character at the same time.
- The whole class is joined together in unity as they study a topic together.





What is our response to an understanding God's character?


As we come to understand each attribute of God's character and nature, a response is required of us. This response is like a reflection in a mirror.

 Does this mean we only teach the Bible in a Christian school?




To know God


It is possible to know the Bible without knowing God.

Christian teachers therefore need to point students to a personal God who can be their Saviour, Lord, friend and role model.

- The God-centred Curriculum is not a Bible curriculum to be studied in a separate compartment of the curriculum.
- It is a curriculum that introduces the students to God and the Bible through science, history, social studies, geography, mathematics, literacy, art and more.
- Students come to know God through studying His character.
