Revise knowledge of the world map: countries, continents, oceans, capital cities, mountains and rivers

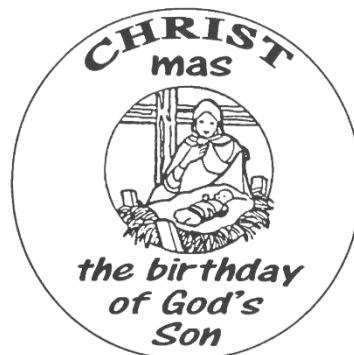
Christmas art
