


or the bones of a Stegasaurus. (Sounds like steg-o-saw-rus.









Toad said to Frog, "I am big. I am bigger than you. I can hop over to that stone in one leap."




Frog said to Toad, "You may be bigger than me, but I can croak louder than you. I can croak louder than a goat."



Toad said to Frog, "You may be able to croak louder than me, but I am better at catching insects than you. I can catch more insects than a bird."




Frog said to Toad, "You may be able to catch more insects than me, but I can swim faster than you. I can swim around that stone and back in five seconds.

Along came snake. Toad said to snake, "Tell us, who do you think is the best?"


Snake said to Toad, "I think I am the best. I cannot hop or croak or sing, but I can swim faster than you both, and I can eat you both for lunch!"

But the goat would not go. "I know," said Sir Richard, "I will put the goat in my boat and float across the moat."




The goat got into the boat. They went across the moat to the other side. The goat saw the green grass and jumped out of the boat.

Mrs. James sets out the buns on a plate. When the buns are not too hot, she shares them with her friends.




Sam and Tim are at the gate. They want to try some of Mrs. James' hot cross buns.
