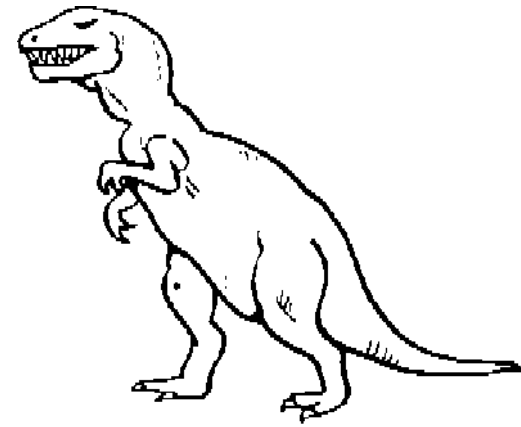


Let's look for dinosaur bones!

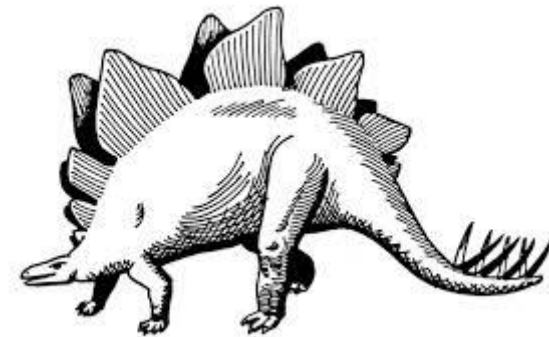
We could find bones of a Tyrannosaurus

(Sounds like brac-i-o-saw-rus.)

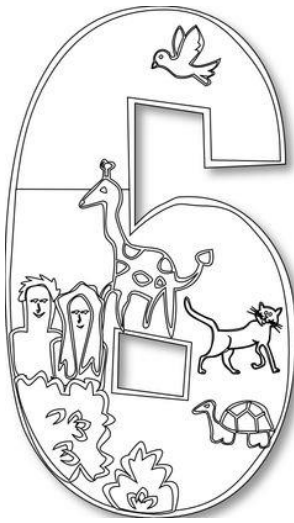

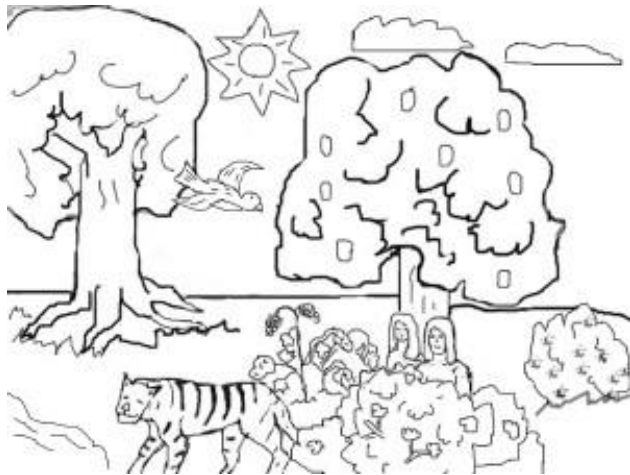
When God made the world, He made dinosaurs on day six.

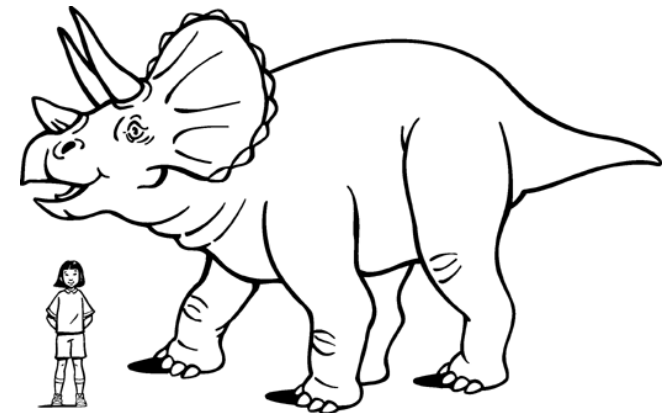
That was the on the same day that He made all the other animals and people.

Frog and Toad

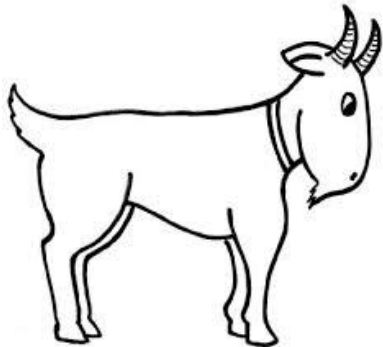

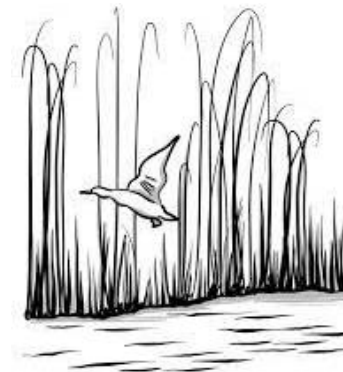
Toad said to Frog, "I am big. I am bigger than you.

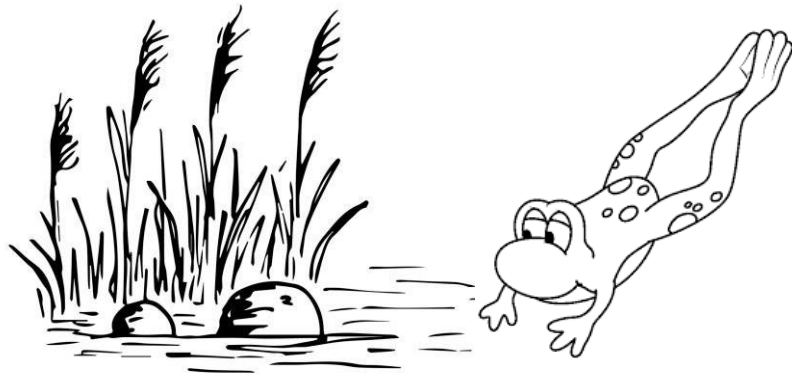
Frog said to Toad, "You may be bigger than me,

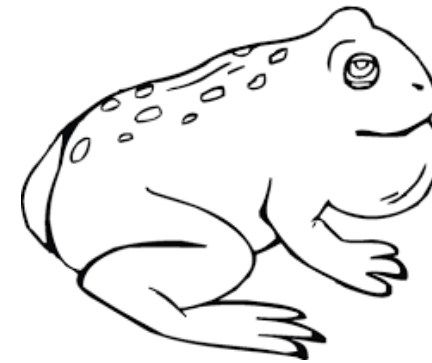
Toad said to Frog, "You may be able to

A goat in a boat



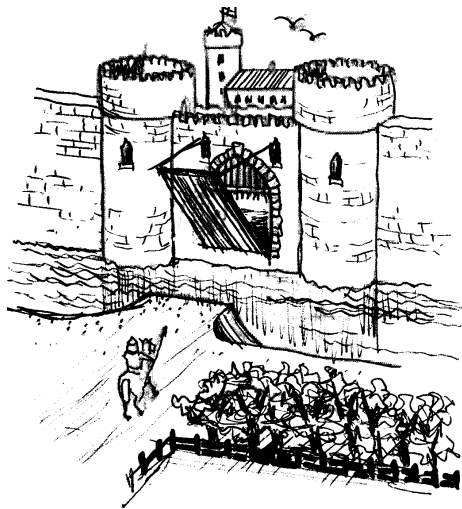
A story from England ... a long time ago

When the bridge was up, the moat kept the enemies out.

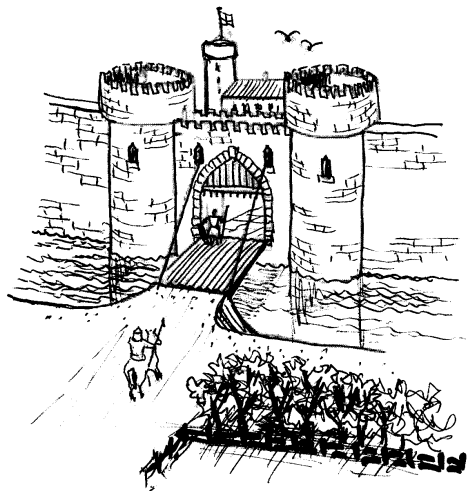

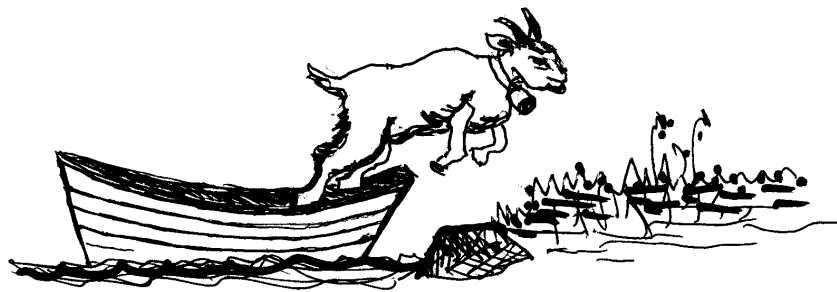
When the bridge was down, Sir Richard tried to take the goat across the bridge to the other side.

It ran to eat the grass. But do you think Sir Richard could get the goat back in the boat?

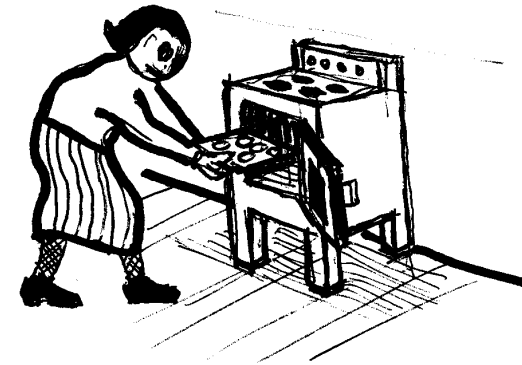

Mrs. James and the Hot Cross Buns

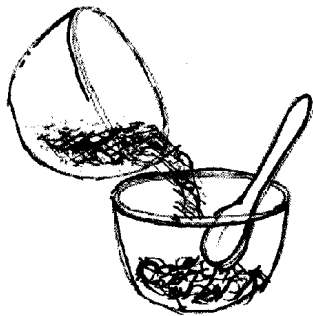

2



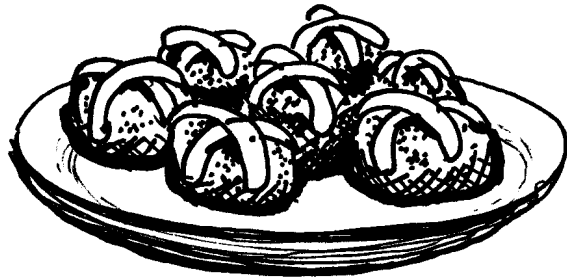
Before she bakes the buns, Mrs. James places crosses on top of the buns. The crosses are made from a mix of white flour and water.

Mrs. James sets out the buns on a plate. When the buns are not too hot, she shares them with her friends.

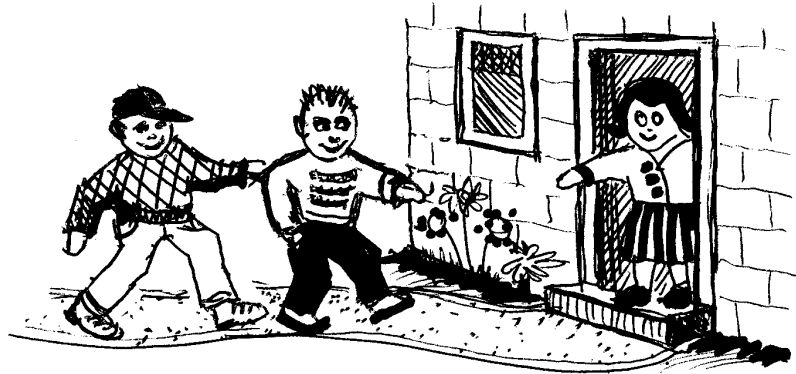

"Come in Sam and Tim," says Mrs. James.

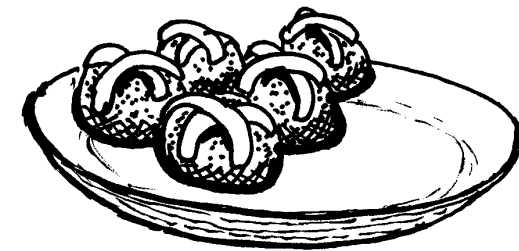
