





A little head comes out. Then his body comes out. Mother hen has one new chick.



Now some more eggs are cracking open. More chicks come out.




Soon mother hen has five fluffy baby chicks.




She looks after her chicks. They stay with her. When they want to rest they go under mother hen's wings.


Tadpoles come out of the eggs. Tadpoles have long tails. They can swim.




The tadpoles grow four little legs. The tadpoles are now froglets.





The froglets grow and grow. Their tails get smaller and smaller. 5






The froglets are now frogs. A frog can swim and leap and jump. Frogs eat insects.







Some frogs are brown. Some are yellow with black stripes. Some have spots. 7




Frogs can be hard to see. They blend in with the colours and shapes around them.

On their way they met Turkey Lurkey. "Come with us," they said. "We must tell the king that the sky is falling."








Mrs. Farmer comes out with her broom.
