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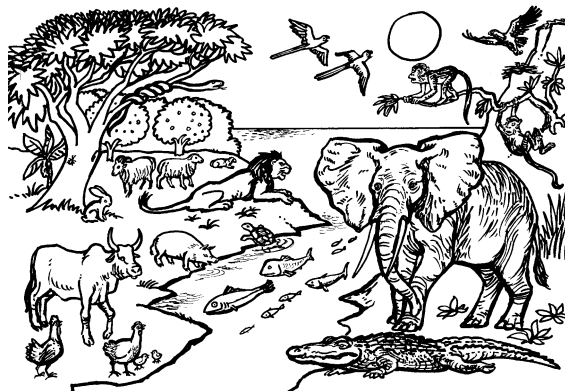

He had to lie on a little bed.

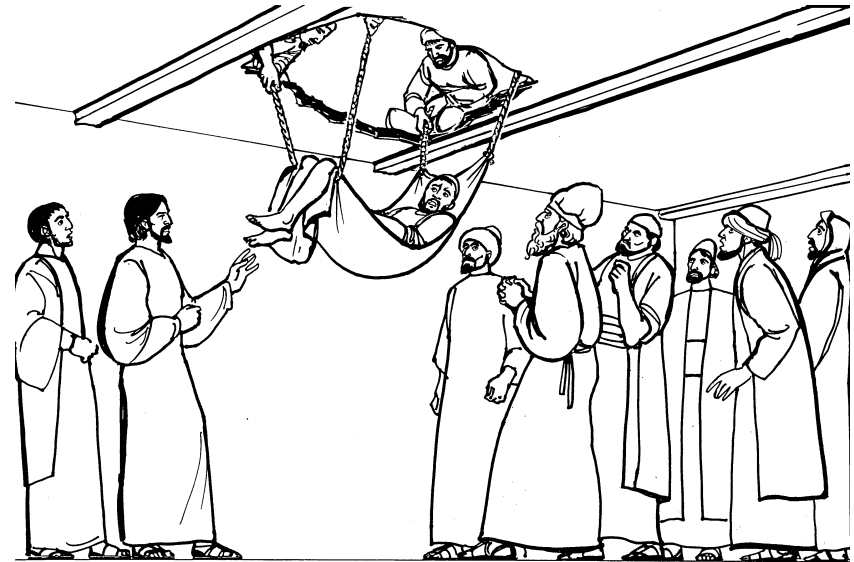
His friends wanted to help him.

Zacchaeus was very small. Zacchaeus was very rich. He loved money.

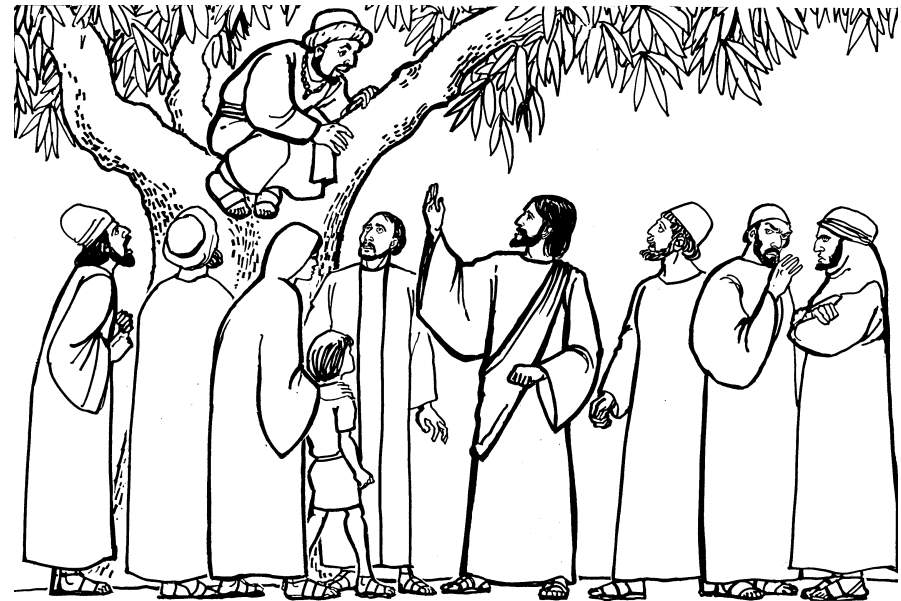
Zacchaeus took money that was not his.
