Everyone has questions

- How each person answers these questions will result in either a positive or a negative mental attitude.
- To answer these questions without a belief in the true God, will lead to a negative attitude about oneself and the world.
- The following answers are shown from a Biblical viewpoint, bringing about a positive mindset for those who believe.

Positive answers #1

1. Who am I?

Answer: I am created in God's image and I am special to Him.

2. Where did I come from?

Answer: God created me and knew me before I was born. (Psalm 139).

3. Where am I going?

Answer: Heaven is real and is a home for those who love Him.

Positive answers #2

4. What is my purpose?

Answer: My purpose is to love and serve God and others.

5. Why is there suffering?

Answer: Suffering in the world is the result of sin.

6. Who decides what is right and wrong?

Answer: The Bible tells us what is right and wrong.

Positive answers #3

7. Does God exist?

Answer: The created world and our conscience tell us that there is a God.

Romans 1:20 For since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities—his eternal power and divine nature—have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that people are without excuse.

Negative answers #1

1. Who am I?

Answer: I am a free individual, free to do whatever I like.

2. Where did I come from?

Answer: I am a product of evolution, evolved from a single cell.

3. Where am I going?

Answer: I am on my own journey through life, doing as I please. There is no Heaven, and we cease to exist after death.

Negative answers #2

4. What is my purpose?

Answer: My purpose is to live for myself and to feel good.

5. Why is there suffering?

Answer: If there is a God, why does He allow suffering?

6. Who decides what is right and wrong?

Answer: What's right or wrong is a matter of opinion.

Negative answers #3

7. Does God exist?

Answers:

Either - There is no God.

Or – There are many gods and they are all equally acceptable.

Beliefs have consequences

Biblical beliefs:

- If we believe that every life has value, then we will want to serve God by caring for the poor, the needy.
- We will respect God's design for marriage and the family, and value the life of the unborn.
- If we believe that all human beings are of equal value, then we will stand against slavery, and poor treatment of people because of their race.
