

Individual Music Projects

1. Performance (50)

Get together with three people and learn 'Small World'. Check which instruments you need to play this before you start.

2. Definitions of worship (25)

Using as many different dictionaries as you can (including Bible dictionaries), write down each definition of worship.

3. Teach yourself to play a new instrument (40)

Pick one of these instruments and teach yourself how to play a piece of music:

a) keyboard b) piano c) guitar d) ukulele e) recorder

4. Analyse music of a Christian group (30)

Listen to a song by either of these Christian music producers and complete an analysis sheet.

5. Complete the page on worship (10)

Crack the code about how we are to worship God.

6. Write a psalm (35)

On an A4 sheet of paper, prepare your own original psalm as a mini poster. Select some background music that would complement your psalm as it is read.

7. Teach someone else to play music (30)

If you know how to play an instrument, use this skill to teach someone else what you know. Have them perform this piece to your music teacher.

8. Create a soundscape (50)

Write the story of either Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden or the resurrection morning and create sounds to accompany the story as it is read.

9. Compose a children's song (40)

Write a children's song which you could teach to the kinder or prep kids. It doesn't need to have an instrumental backing.

10. Performance (50)

Perform your children's song for a younger class.

11. Worship DVD (25)

Watch a worship DVD / video and write down what you see the worship leader doing.

12. Power Point presentation (45)

Make up a 10 slide (minimum) presentation on an instrument of your choice. Include audio in your presentation.

13. Select a study on worship (in pairs) (30)

Pick a study and work through it with a partner.

14. Do a survey (35)

Write five questions in a survey format that you could ask a group of students about their music listening habits, then survey one class.

15. Newspaper collage (40)

Create a newspaper collage of different ways to worship God.

16. Make worship scripture banners (40)

Pick some Bible verses which talk about praise and worship, and create a colourful banner with this.

17. Interview (40)

Find a teacher who you could interview about their musical tastes. Prepare some questions beforehand which your music teacher needs to see first.

18. Create a rhythm round using a psalm (40)

Pick a psalm and using some of the words, write a spoken round.

19. Word-find (20)

Make up a word-find that could be done by a Grade 6 student. The topic should be about drums and drumming. (You could use some rhythm words such as crotchets and minims).

20. Beatles video (35)

Watch a Beatles video and write questions and answers for it, for a worksheet for another class.

21. Create a Christian dance (55)

Using Christian music, make a dance to accompany it. Perform this.
