Mathematics Year 3

Term 1

Can count by ones to 1000	
Can count forwards and backwards by 2s to 150	
Can count forwards and backwards by 5s to 150	
Can count forwards and backwards by 10s to 150	
Can count by Odd numbers from 1 to 99	
Can write words for numbers to ninety-nine	
Can double numbers to 50	
Can halve numbers to 100	
Can shade fractions of shapes: $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{3}{4}$; thirds, sixths, eighths	
Can break up numbers to 100 as tens and ones, e.g. $74 = 70 + 4$	
Can break up numbers to 100 using x sign, e.g. $74 = (7 \times 10) + (4 \times 1)$	
Can solve addition and subtraction problems (numbers to 100)	
Can solve word problems using +, -, x, \div	
Understands the use of brackets in equations, e.g. $9 = (4 + 3) + 2$	
Knows how to read a clock: o'clock and half past	
Knows 2 times table	
Knows 5 times table	
Knows 10 times table	
Can measure objects and distances using centimeters and meters.	
Understands how to measure area	
Understands how to measure perimeter	
Knows how many centimeters in a meter	
Knows how many meters to a kilometer.
