


# NOAH and the amazing ark



Noah was a good man who loved and trusted God. Even when other people made fun of him he listened and obeyed.




God told Noah to build a big boat, because He was going to send a flood to cover the land. He told him exactly how big to build it.




It was God's plan to save Noah and his family and a father and mother of all the animals and birds.



Noah trusted and obeyed God and he taught his family to do what was good and right. He told them about God's plan to save them.




Noah's sons worked hard helping their father to get enough logs of Gopher wood to build the amazing boat.
