3. I am thankful:

For the teacher who bothers me with her annoying manner, because she helps on the duty roster and serves the team in lots of other ways

For the litter that I too often have to pick up, for it means my students have plenty to eat, and can afford to buy from shops

For the feeling of tiredness at the end of the day, for it means I have been serving God in ministry and I have employment



For my wage even if teachers elsewhere get more, for it means I don't have to rely on deputation and seek support as do so many Christian teachers elsewhere

For my old textbooks and computers as it means we have reliable electricity and some ICT facility, and we do have desks, chairs, books, shelter and viable facilities when others have minimal

For the sound of my alarm clock as it means I am fit and healthy enough to be in meaningful work, and I can go and serve God with my Christian colleagues on team and I have the privilege of working in a paid ministry vital to the Kingdom

For my critics and detractors for Jesus worked in the midst of the same, and because God will use them to bring out the best in me and somehow work all things for good because I am a believer
