76. Soaring on Thermals

The pelican is a mighty bird, second only to the albatross in size. Albatross wings span 3.5 metres and pelican's 2.5. It has a fairy tale shape with its peculiar beak and stately way of walking along coasts. Pelicans can hold up to 11 litres of water in their beaks, which they quickly spill to strand the fish meal within. They have special breast muscles and extra feathers to enable them to glide and soar, God fives them an extremely light skeleton, weighing less than 10% of their total body weight. Pelicans are weird in the way they stand on their eggs to keep them warm.

When flying low over the sea it gets a special uplift from small air currents such that its big body glides along assisted, the albatross can soar along the waves at night and sleep on wing, one hemisphere of the brain asleep and one alert to danger.

When working the daily grind of schooling it's worth recalling that God's eye is on the sparrow, the pelican and you. When tired, unwell or watching the clock tick its too slow path through your day, briefly close your eyes and ask God for the updraft you need. He enables His to walk on the waters, and to do amazing things when depleted. Don't try doing your job asleep though. You are not an albatross! But do get in touch with your Father who promises to lift and sustain the weary. Like the pelican, you can soar through your day and not have to flap about on your own. Your reward awaits you in glory, Rev 2:3
