A young admirer of Yo Yo's music approached him after a class and asked him did he have a name for his cello. Ma replied, "No, but if I play for you, will you name it?" She chose *Petunia* and from that time on the name stuck. Nigel Kennedy the brilliant virtuoso violinist has named his Stradivarius violin "Kylie" after the Australian pop star, "because she sounds great and is perfectly formed".
