Frequently Told Lies, Myths regarding sex and sexuality

- 1. "Everybody's doing it." Is this an excuse for Christians to indulge in sexual sin? (Mt 5:29, Rm 6:6, Gal 5:16, Col 3:5 Tit 3:3, 1 Pet 2:11, 2 Pet 2:10)
- "Stolen Fruit Tastes Better. Hollywood doesn't make movies about monogamy. Most marriages break up, so we should understand that most of us will have multiple sexual partners in our lives." What does the Bible say about this? (1 Kings 11:1-4, Song of Songs, 1 Cor 7:1-4)
- 3. "I love you and you alone always.....so come on, let's.... "What does the Bible say? (Prov 2:12-19, Prov 12:22, Rev 21:8)
- 4. "The Bible says NO! The forbidden fruit of Eden is an allegory for sexual pleasure denied. It's all one long red light in terms of Scripture." Is this an accurate statement? Explain. (Song of Songs)
- 5. "There is no victim in pornography, it's harmless really." Comment on this. (2 Sam 11:2-4, Mt 5:28-29, 1 Jn 2:16)
- 6. "Young is sexy and sexy is young." What is God's expectation of young people in the area of sexual purity? **(Eccl 12:1)**
- "I just lost control, I had no real say in it all, and I just got swept away in the moment of it all." Is this a proper justification for sexual sin? (Prov 5:1-22)
- 8. "God hates homosexuals and sexual sin more than anything else. The evidence for this is that Christians spend more time attacking different sexual lifestyles than telling people what God is actually in favour of and the lifestyle Jesus requires." Comment on this statement. (**1 Cor 6:18-19**)
- 9. Was Jesus a hermit aesthetic removed from sexual temptations? (Heb 4:15, Mt 11:19)
- 10. The media and advertising use sex to sell most things. Was the world of Paul and the early Christians sex saturated too? i.e Is the Gospel irrelevant because there was less sexual behaviour in the public eye in the times of early Christianity? (John 8:1-11)
