
Who made everything?


The ship went out to sea. There was a big storm. The ship went up and down.

Goliath was very big. Goliath wanted to fight the people of David.


David said, "I will fight Goliath."

The man came through the roof


God is Powerful - Mark 2: 1-12

Josiah was a boy King. He was eight years old. He wanted to work for God.


One day, he found some writing in God's house.

There is no one else with the same eyes as me.


There is no one else with the same hair as me.
