Motivational Gifts

Romans 12:4 - 8

- If one has the gift of prophecy, let him prophecy.
- If one has the gift of serving, he should serve
- If one has the gift of teaching, he should teach.
- If one has the gift of encouraging others, he should encourage.
- If one has the gift of giving to others, he should give.
- If one has the gift of being a leader, he should lead.
- If one has the gift of showing kindness to others, he should do it with joy.

- Give them opportunities for reflection on Bible verses / stories.
- Encourage them to share what God is saying.

Helping

- This child loves to help.
- Give them responsibilities in the classroom, e.g. looking after equipment.
- Set up situations where they can help others in academic work, e.g. older children reading with younger children

Teaching

Sharing knowledge in an interesting way

- This student loves to research.
- Provide plenty of free-choice project opportunities.
- Provide books and other materials for them to research information.
- Allow them to present their projects to the class.
- Give opportunity to explain Biblical meaning

Encouraging

Be strong in the Lord

and help others to be strong in the Lord

- Allow this student to work with others who need support.
- Give them opportunities to teach others one-on-one

- This student loves to give gifts.
- Provide opportunities for making gifts for others, a piece of art or writing a story / poem for another student.
- Put this student in charge of a class 'giving project' to a hospital, the elderly, an overseas community

Leadership

Well organized and likes to organize others

Must learn to be a servant leader or administrator

- Allow this student to mentor others.
- Give opportunities for group leadership.
- Involve this child in setting up and running rosters.




Meerkat communities are very organized with leaders to give instructions.
