- 2nd recorder starts (from the beginning) when 1st recorder reaches the 2<sup>nd</sup> bar.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> recorder starts when 2<sup>nd</sup> recorder reaches the 2<sup>nd</sup>.
- 4<sup>th</sup> recorder starts when 3<sup>rd</sup> recorder reaches 2<sup>nd</sup> bar.




