Questions to guide unit construction for secondary units

- 1. What is God's intention for the particular area of creation that is being studied in this unit?
- 2. What is a Christian perspective on this unit of study?
- 3. How is God's character or nature expressed in this topic?
- 4. What would be our response to understanding these aspects of God's character or nature? e.g. God is truth our response is to speak and act truthfully.
- 5. Which scripture passages support this?
- 6. If this unit is mostly skill laden, what real life examples and framework can be put around the skills to promote a Christian worldview?
- 7. What ethic directs the expression of the skill?
- 8. How has God's purpose, related to this unit of study, been affected and distorted by sin? These may be reflected in idolatry, alienation, suffering and the outworking of God's judgment.
- 9. What are the avenues by which Christians may respond to these areas affected by sin to bring about healing and reconciliation?
- 10. Are there ways in which our students can respond now so as to promote the Kingdom of God in these situations?
