Link between “God is Love” and classroom topics:

As we come to know God, we know that He loves us. We can share His love with others through friendship.

Link between “God is Provider” and classroom topics:

God provides for all of His creation. He provides plant food for us to eat.

Link between “God is our Saviour” and classroom topics:

John 3:16 For God loved the world so much that He sent his only son so that whoever believes in Him should not die but have everlasting life.

God wants the people of every country in the whole world to come to know Him, so that they can live forever with Him in heaven. People of every nation can come to know the true God by asking Jesus to forgive their sins and then to follow Him. Some people have never heard about Jesus so those who know about Him must tell others.

Link between “God is Pure and Holy” and classroom topics:

We can express our emotions in a way that is pleasing to God. We can make others feel happy by sharing joy. But we can make others feel sad when we express anger. Having the Fruit of the Spirit in our lives can help us to control our anger, express love and joy and feel peaceful instead of worried.

Link between “God is Creator” and classroom topics:

Students can look to the creation and see how God has created animals with self-protective mechanisms and design features such as camouflage.

Link between “God is Wise” and classroom topics:

God expects us to show wisdom in caring for our bodies, including caring for our teeth.

Link between “God is a Servant” and classroom topics:

Children will learn the definition of a ‘servant’ and think about ways in which they can serve others. Community servants are an example to us in the way they help us.

Link between “God is Protector” and classroom topics:

God has provided ways in which we can protect ourselves from sickness and injury. He wants us to look after our bodies because they are amazing, and He has made us.

Link between “God is Truth” and classroom topics:

The key story for this unit is the promise given by God to Noah that He would never flood the whole world again. The sign of His promise was the rainbow. The rainbow is a sign of God’s promise to us, that God keeps His word. He keeps His word because He is truth. God wants us to be faithful and true to our word as well.

Link between “God is Lord and King” and classroom topic:

Discuss with children that God is in control of the whole universe. That is, our world, the sun and the stars. He tells the sun the time to set. He makes the tides because the moon is under His control, (Ps 104:19). Because God is looking after our world, He looks after the people that He made. He sent His son Jesus into the world so that every person in the whole world could have the opportunity of knowing the true God.
