Link between “God is Love” and classroom topics:

The Great Commission: taking God’s love to those who do not know Him

Link between “God is Provider” and classroom topics:

God provides for our needs through His creation.

Link between “God is our Saviour” and classroom topics:

John 3:16 For God loved the world so much that He sent his only son so that whoever believes in Him should not die but have everlasting life.

God wants the people of every country in the whole world to come to know Him, so that they can live forever with Him in heaven. People of every nation can come to know the true God by asking Jesus to forgive their sins and then to follow Him. Some people have never heard about Jesus so those who know about Him must tell others. How did Fijians come to know about Jesus?

Link between “God is Pure and Holy” and classroom topics:

The Bible uses the symbols of light and darkness to represent good and evil, or purity and sin.

Link between “God is Creator” and classroom topics:

We see the hand of a designer in the creation. Such order, beauty and design could not have happened by chance; animals were created after their own kind; we do not see animal species changing into different animal species – cats do not change into dogs. The theory of millions of years is an invention to try and cover up the fact that we don’t see animals changing from one kind to another. Evolutionists say that it would take millions of years to see these changes. God created us in His own image. He has given creativity to both people and animals. He wants us to develop our creativity.

Link between “God is Wise” and classroom topics:

Wisdom in following practices for good health.

Link between “God is a Servant” and classroom topics:

God has placed within the creation powerful forces that man can utilize to develop technology. Transport and technology serve us in spreading the Gospel. The first missionaries were able to use ships to reach distant nations. Today we can use all modes of transport as well as computers, and audio-visual media. God has given Christians power to be His servants, as we share the Good News with others relying on the power of the Holy Spirit.

Link between “God is Protector” and classroom topics:

God has provided protection for our special planet through the earth’s atmosphere, its position in space and its distance from the sun. Our planet is the only planet in the universe created for life, and exists through God’s protection alone.

Link between “God is Truth” and classroom topics:

Are the messages we receive from the world around us telling the truth?

Link between “God is Lord and King” and classroom topic:

Discuss with children that God is in control of the whole universe. That is, our world, the sun and the stars. He tells the sun the time to set. He makes the tides because the moon is under His control, (Ps 104:19). Because God is looking after our world, He looks after the people that He made. He sent His son Jesus into the world so that every person in the whole world could have the opportunity of knowing the true God.
