Link between “God is Love” and classroom topics:

Social conflict can be resolved by acceptance of individual difference; working together and appreciating one another brings harmony.

Link between “God is Provider” and classroom topics:

God provides air for sustaining life. We cannot live without it. God is as essential to life as the air we breathe, and He gives the Holy Spirit to all who ask.

Link between “God is our Saviour” and classroom topics:

John 3:16 For God loved the world so much that He sent his only son so that whoever believes in Him should not die but have everlasting life.

God wants the people of every country in the whole world to come to know Him, so that they can live forever with Him in heaven. People of every nation can come to know the true God by asking Jesus to forgive their sins and then to follow Him. Some people have never heard about Jesus so those who know about Him must tell others. How did Fijians come to know about Jesus?

Link between “God is Pure and Holy” and classroom topics:

The destruction of a once perfect world through pollution and lack of care for the environment is evidence of the effect of sin upon our planet.

Link between “God is Creator” and classroom topics:

The landforms we see today are a result of the Great Flood

Link between “God is Wise” and classroom topics:

God wants us to use our time wisely and serve Him by working to our best ability. We can ask God to give us wisdom in performing our work.

Link between “God is a Servant” and classroom topics:

The impact of missionaries on Fiji; the servant heart of early missionaries

Link between “God is Protector” and classroom topics:

God has provided us with foods from His creation that contain nutrients for protecting our bodies from sickness and disease. He has also created us with an immune system to help fight viruses and bacteria. Responsible eating habits can build a strong immune system making us more resistant to sickness.

Link between “God is Truth” and classroom topics:

God is faithful and consistent. We see this in the creation. The universe is held together by scientific laws and principles which God established from the beginning.

Link between “God is Lord and King” and classroom topic:

Discuss with children that God is in control of the whole universe. That is, our world, the sun and the stars. He tells the sun the time to set. He makes the tides because the moon is under His control, (Ps 104:19). Because God is looking after our world, He looks after the people that He made. He sent His son Jesus into the world so that every person in the whole world could have the opportunity of knowing the true God. In the 17th century, early scientists searched to find the truth about the universe. Those who honoured God made great discoveries.
