# 83. Closed-No Entry



A long-anticipated breakthrough fails to materialize. When the expected short cut in the track is closed off, there is a diversion and the route planner is frustrated. The flight is cancelled. A trusty helper declares their intention to quit you team.

No theology or glib maxims comfort the sense of inner turbulence and anguish one feels. Where will the energies and resources come from to deal with this new and unwanted challenge? Inertia weighs in and the urge to set up camp and feel sorry for oneself imposes their unwelcome presence.

We have been through such situations before; the script of our life has not been snatched out of the Father's hands, despite appearances. This current act in the dramanarrative of our life was foreseen from the perspective of divine omniscience.

Heaven's winds have changed in compass direction. We are now bound for ports unknown; we sail under "sealed orders" for reasons currently unknown to us.

So to our crew of faith, we add positive expectations and good cheer, on the docks we leave dread and pessimism. "Praise the Lord, Oh my soul, "we command our drooping spirit as David years ago when he had no inclination to worship. Our anchor in all this is that we know that the Father is for us, and His intentions can't be other than good.
