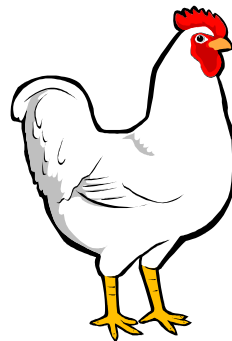
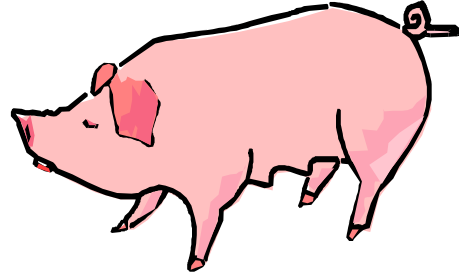


# The fox and the hen

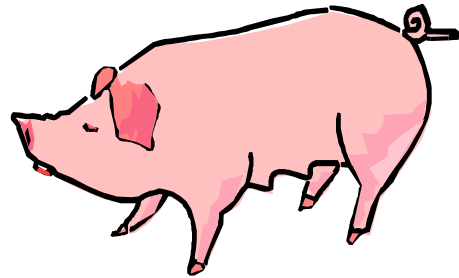


**Here is the fox.**

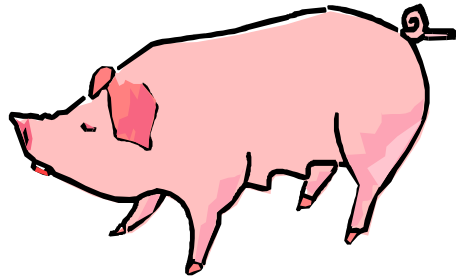
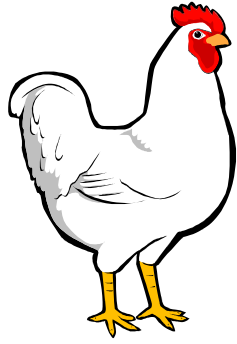
**The fox can see the hen.**
