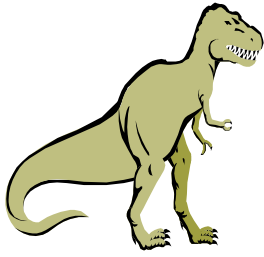


Fossils & Dinosaurs
